

America the Beautiful Interagency Pass Program



The Golden Age and the Golden Access Passports will no longer be issued after 01 January 2007. They are being replaced with the new America the Beautiful Pass created by the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act of 2004, passed by Congress. Under new legislation, the National Park Service, U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, U.S. Forest Service, the Bureau of Land Management and the Bureau of Reclamation are the only agencies allowed to issue the new pass. The US Army Corps of Engineers was not included in this legislation, therefore are not authorized to issue the passes. However, the Corps is allowed to honor the discounts for passholders that acquired their passes through one of the approved agencies. All previously issued Golden Age and Golden Access passes will continue to be honored by the Corps of Engineers.
