

Granger Lake Willis Creek Park Trail Rules

Welcome to Granger Lake Willis Creek Park Trails. We hope the following trail guidelines and rules will increase your safety and enjoyment of the trails. The US Army Corps of Engineers rules and regulations (Title 36) remain in effect while on the property. Copies are available at the gate house.

Call (512) 859-2668 M-F 8-4:30 for trail conditions, hunt schedules and other closure dates or check Granger Lake's web page at www.swf-wc.usace.army.mil/granger and look under the horse trails tab at the bottom of the page. Camping reservations may be made through the National Reservation System (NRRS) by calling 2 days in advance to 1-877-444-6777 or on the internet at www.reserveusa.com.

OVERALL TRAIL USE:

- Use of trails is not permitted on scheduled hunt days. Note that the trails are located in a wildlife management area. Hunting is permitted year round.
- Trails are multi-use. Hikers and bikers always yield to equine and pass on equine's left.
- Do not block gate access. Overflow may park outside the back gate of the parking area. Vehicles are not permitted on the trails.
- Leave all gates as you found them. There are cows here. The parking area gate should be kept closed.
- Alcohol is not allowed on the trails.
- Quiet hours are in effect between Dark and 6 am.
- Ground fires are prohibited except in provided fire pits.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times for the safety of others and to protect wildlife and cattle.
- Horse are not to be left unattended and free to graze.

EQUESTRIAN USE:

- Proof of negative EIA (Coggins) test within the past 12 months is required for equine.
- It is best to stay on the trails. There are dump sites and wire on the ground in various areas.
- Approach other riders at a walk and ask permission of riders in front before passing.
- Keep equine out of the park area (north of equestrian parking area and main park road).
- Pick up or scatter all equine manure and hay in the parking area.
- Soap should not be used when washing equine.
- Trail closes at dark.
