

Youth Deer Hunting Regulations For Navarro Mills

- 1) Applications must be turned in by August 17, 2007.
- 2) Hunting dates will be set to coincide with Texas Parks & Wildlife Department early youth weekend.
- 3) Registrations will include a Youth, age 12-14 years as of September 1 2007 and an adult age 25 or older. The youth must be hunter education certified and the guardian must be hunter education certified if born on or after September 2, 1971. All applications which fail to provide the required hunter education certificates will not be considered.
- 4) The number of permits to be awarded will be based on data collected from various wildlife population sampling techniques.
- 5) A drawing will be held and permits awarded on August 31, 2007.
- 6) The hunting coordinator will contact applicants after the permits are awarded to discuss applicable hunting regulations and hunting areas.
- 7) There will be no fee for the permit.
- 8) All hunters must sign and fill out Disclaimer and Waiver of Liability.
- 9) The event will be held at the Group Shelter in Liberty Hill Park. All hunters, guardians and volunteers are welcome to camp at no charge.
- 10) Volunteers are needed as Camp Cooks and other assorted help.
- 11) Each youth will be allowed to harvest 1 deer in compliance with all hunting regulations as posted in the Texas Parks and Wildlife Hunting Guide and additional restrictions provided in this document.
- 12) Shotgun with slug or muzzleloader will be the only weapons allowed. Please take the time to properly site in your weapon to prevent lost and injured animals.
- 13) Ground blinds will be set up at safe locations and hunters will be confined to these areas for a time period set up by the hunters.
