

Check In/Check Out:

Check-out time is at 2:00 p.m. & check-in at 3:00 p.m.

Campground is open April - September; no vehicle entry 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

- Parking on paved campsite pad or designated parking areas only
- Reservable Group Shelter with six individual campsites \$125.00 daily

All sites are available by reservation only

- All Sites have water and electric hookups, Sites #1 & 2 have sewer
- Sites #1 & #2 may be in use by volunteers or park hosts & unavailable
- Sites with 50-amp electric #s 2, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 28, 36 & 37
 - Pull-through sites #s 3, 5, 9, 11, 18, 22
 - All campsites are \$28 daily



- Nominal campsite limits of two vehicles & eight people
- Visitors are free but should leave the park by 9:00 p.m.
- Fires in campfire rings, grills, covered cookers only no open ground fires!
- Courtesy docks are for boat loading only no swimming or fishing
 For your safety –
- Pets on 6' leash or physical control at all times
- Lake level can change significantly from week to week
- Beware of submerged timber
- For your safety, areas near all boat ramp areas are designated as 'No Wake' for boats, and 'No Swimming' at any time
- Please wear a life jacket/PFD and always behave responsibly in, on, or around the water, and in accord with regulations & Texas State laws
