









	<p>Golden Age Passport</p> <p>Golden Access Passport</p>	<p>N/A These are no longer available</p>	<p>The Golden Age and Access Passports were replaced with the Interagency Senior Pass and Interagency Access Pass in January 2007.</p> <p>Previously issued Golden Age and Access Passports will be honored for the lifetime of the holder.</p> <p>Golden Age and Access Passports may be exchanged for the Interagency Senior or Access Pass free of charge. They are not required to give up their old one if they don't want to.</p>
