

All applications must be submitted to the Lake Georgetown Project Office between July 09, 2025 and August 08, 2025. A \$25 non-refundable administrative fee must be included with this application. Permits/applications must be obtained at the project office M-F 8:30 AM -3:30 PM. Recommended that you call 512/930-2283 prior to driving to the office to make sure someone is available to take your fees/application. The Lake Georgetown Office will only issue 50 small game permits each season. Small game permits will be administered through a random drawing process. Drawn hunters will receive an email notification with further information no later than August 15, 2025.

\*Seasons: All hunting is closed from March 1 to the beginning of dove season. All hunting except archery is closed during the archery season for deer set by TPWD.

**Prohibited Weapons/Activities**: Rifles, pistols, and shotguns with slugs or shot larger than #2 common are prohibited at all times. Target practice and skeet shooting are prohibited. Hunters must remain a minimum of 300 ft away from Lake Georgetown hiking trails and park areas.

**Dove:** Dove may only be hunted in the general hunting area. Dove season will correspond with the dates set by TPWD, EXCEPT during archery season for deer. During the archery season for deer (as set by TPWD), all other hunting is closed. Bag limits are set by TPWD.

**Waterfowl:** Waterfowl may only be hunted in the general hunting area. Hunters may not possess lead shot or shot larger than #2 steel while hunting waterfowl. The season for hunting waterfowl will be set by TPWD.

**Rabbit & Squirrel:** Rabbit and squirrel may be hunted in the general hunting area at any time during dove season except during archery season for deer set by TPWD, but no later than the last day of February. Hunters are required to wear hunter orange while hunting rabbit and squirrel.

**Prohibited Species:** Quail, turkey, raccoon, bobcat, foxes, coyotes, and beaver hunting are prohibited until further notice. For any questions, please contact the lake office.

\*\*All hunters born after September 2, 1971 must have attended a Hunter Education Course or obtained a Hunter Education Deferral. Hunters under the age of 17 without a Hunter Education ID or hunters utilizing the Hunter Education Deferral must be accompanied by a person who is at least 17, who is licensed to hunt in Texas, who has passed hunter education or is exempt (born before September 2, 1971), and you must be within normal voice control.
