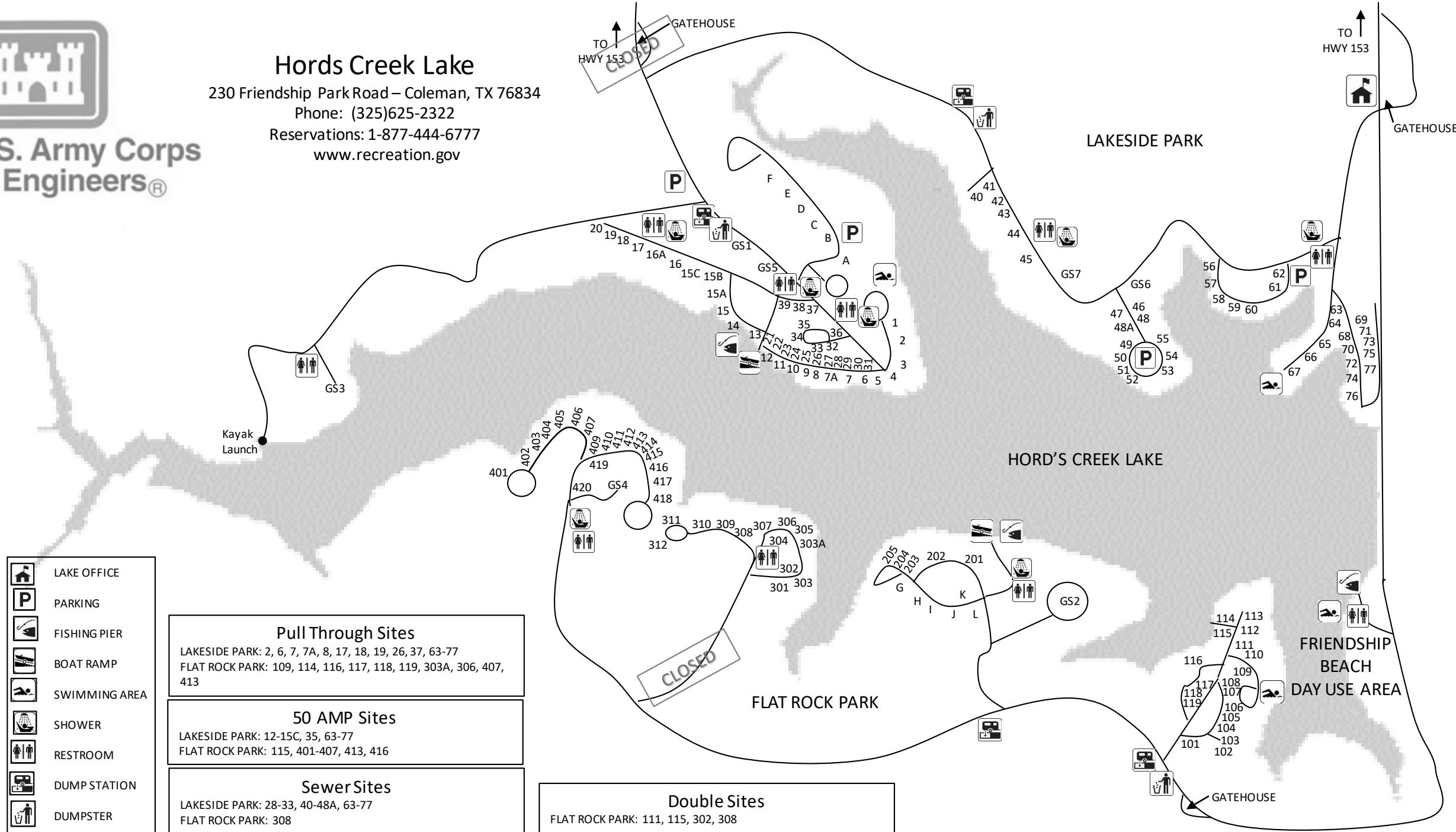

CAMPING INFORMATION:

1. Water is restricted to drinking, cooking, personal hygiene and sanitary needs. The use of water for recreational toys such as water sprinklers, swimming pools or other recreational toys is prohibited. The use of water for washing RV's, boats, vehicles, etc., is prohibited. *Small* wading pools will be allowed for use by young children only. Any violation of this will result in the mandatory removal of wading pool.
2. Eight (8) persons and two (2) motor vehicles is the maximum number that can be registered on one (1) camping permit for one (1) camping fee.
3. A maximum of one (1) camping unit per site is allowed at all sites. **A camping unit can consist of:**
 - a) **A camper trailer, a self contained pickup camper or a motor home, plus one tent OR**
 - b) **Two tents.**Any excess units must be placed on another campsite for which a separate camping fee must be paid.
4. Observe quiet hours from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. From 10:00 PM until 6:00 AM, the gate to the park is closed to all incoming vehicles. Check out time for campers is 2:00 PM.
5. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Leashes must be 6' in length or shorter. All waste produced by these animals shall be properly disposed of in a trash dumpster upon departure from the campsite.
6. Glass containers, fishing and pets are prohibited in the beach area.
7. All rules as stated in Title 36, Chapter III, Part 27 "Rules and Regulations Governing Public Use of Water Resource Development Projects" are

applicable as well as state laws.

8. Campsites paid for by way of a Golden Age/Golden Access or America the Beautiful Senior Pass/Access Pass Cards require that the cardholder occupy the site for the duration of the stay. Both passports provide a 50% discount on camping or other use fees for the cardholder and any accompanying passengers in the one (1) private vehicle. The fees are per day, per site basis. The rental fee is for twenty-three (23) hours beginning at 3:00 PM and ending at 2:00 PM the following day. Campsites may be reserved by calling the National Recreation Reservation System at their toll free number 1-877-444-6777. You may also visit <http://www.recreation.gov> for reservations. Reservations are accepted as early as six (6) month to the day in advance on campsites and twelve (12) months to the day in advance of Group and Screened Shelters.
9. Lakeside and Flatrock Park facilities are restricted to registered campers and their guests only. Day use is limited Friendship Park and Friendship Park Road.

MOTOR VEHICLES

1. Campsites are allowed two (2) vehicles per site, excluding the camping unit. All other vehicles will be charged an extra vehicle fee of \$3.00 per vehicle, per day.
2. Additional vehicles may be allowed if parking space is available, either at the campsite or at a designated parking lot and by paying the established extra vehicle fee.
3. Maximum speed limit within the park is 25 mph

unless otherwise posted. Maximum speed in camping areas is 10 mph.

4. Vehicle and authorized recreational equipment must be operated only on paved roads, turnouts or parking areas.
5. All vehicles must be operated in compliance with State laws; vehicles must have a current Registration and Inspection Sticker. The operation of off-road vehicles and golf carts are prohibited.

Corps of Engineers Rangers, Department of Public Safety Troopers, Game Wardens and Sheriff's Deputies patrol the parks and all have enforcement authority.
