Lavon Lake to begin road repairs at East Fork Park

Lavon Lake suffered severe damages to asphalt roads and boat ramp parking lots during the floods of FY15 and FY16. We requested and were fortunate to receive special funding for some of the damages and are scheduled to begin work on March 6, 2017. At East Fork Park, three areas are authorized for repair:

- Marina Boat Ramp Parking Lot
- North Boat Ramp Parking Lot
- RV Loop

Most of the work will be done with minimal impact to our customers; however, the repairs to the RV loop will require us to close that area during the construction period. Those individuals impacted by the closure will be given the opportunity to transfer their reservation to the East Fork Equestrian Loop, or cancel the reservation with a full refund. Once the reservation is cancelled, individuals may make a reservation at Lavonia Park, or depart the Lavon Lake area altogether. We apologize for the inconvenience, but the construction activities will prohibit access to the RV sites. **The RV loop will be closed from 13 March through 3 April**. We'll keep our website updated as more information becomes available.

Roads and boat ramp parking lots will also be repaired at the following locations over the coming months:

- Avalon Park
- Little Ridge Park
- Brockdale Park
- Lakeland Park

- Mallard Park
- Clear Lake Park
- Elm Creek Park

During the construction period, we will close each impacted park/area, but will reopen it as soon as the construction is completed for that section. Again, we apologize for the inconvenience.
