

Park Rules

Check out time is no later than 2:00 pm on your departure day. Check in is at 3:00 pm.

Quiet hours are from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am

Gates automatically close at 10:00 pm, but re-entry is no earlier than 6:00 am. There is NO code for the gate.

Between Nov 1 and Feb 28, campers may receive extensions up to 120 days. Between Mar 1 and Oct 31, campers may receive extensions up to 42 days in a 60 day period.

An extension is a request to stay in the park after your 14 day reservation.

Extensions are granted at the discretion of the Lake Manager and if approved, are based on availability. Extensions will NOT be granted over holiday weekends.

Drive through visits are not allowed on weekends and holidays between Easter and Labor Day.

Collection of fallen limbs 4" in diameter or less for firewood is allowed. Cutting and/or limbing of trees is not allowed.

FOR EMERGENCIES, CALL 911.

Fires shall be confined to the grill or fire ring. Burn bans will be observed.

Fireworks are prohibited in the park.

Possession of firearms, ammunition, or projectile firing devices is prohibited.

Chainsaws and machetes are not allowed in the park.

Dumping of gray matter is NOT allowed.

The cutting and/or limbing of trees or other vegetation is NOT allowed.

All Title 36 Rules and Regulations apply.

FACILITIES

Camping is open year round. Visitors needing electrical and water hook-ups can choose from over 100 sites. Campsites also have grills and fire rings. Modern bath houses are operational year-round.

Primitive camping is also available next to the lake. All 10 sites are equipped with fire rings. Primitive camping is assessable by foot only. Parking lots are located near the head of each trail. The park provides nearby pit toilets and a central water supply.

VISITORS

All visitors MUST leave the park no later than 10:00 pm.

Visitors may park in visitor and overflow parking.

PETS

Pets must be on a physical restraint at all times. Leash may be no longer than 6 feet.

You must remove and properly dispose of animal waste.

VEHICLES

All vehicles must remain on the pavement.

You may NOT park in an unoccupied site unless you have paid for that site.

No parking is allowed off roadways, in the road, on the boat ramp, or boat parking.

NO off-road vehicles (ATV's, dirt bikes, non "street legal" vehicles, etc...) are allowed in the park.

Trailers of any kind may NOT be parked in bath house parking lots.

FEES

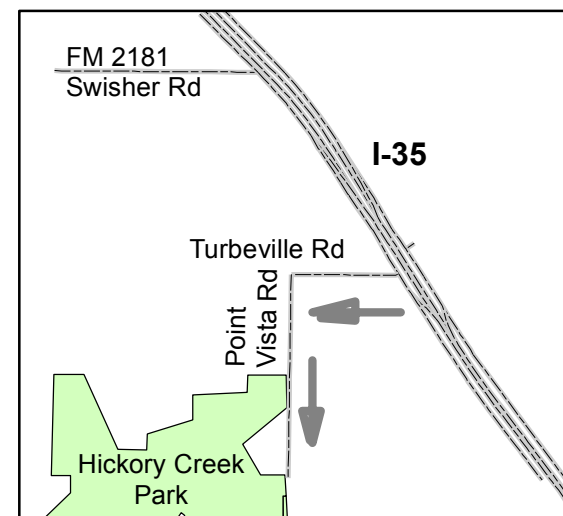
Campsites range from \$14.00 to \$30.00. Fees are subject to change. Please check with gate attendants for rates.
