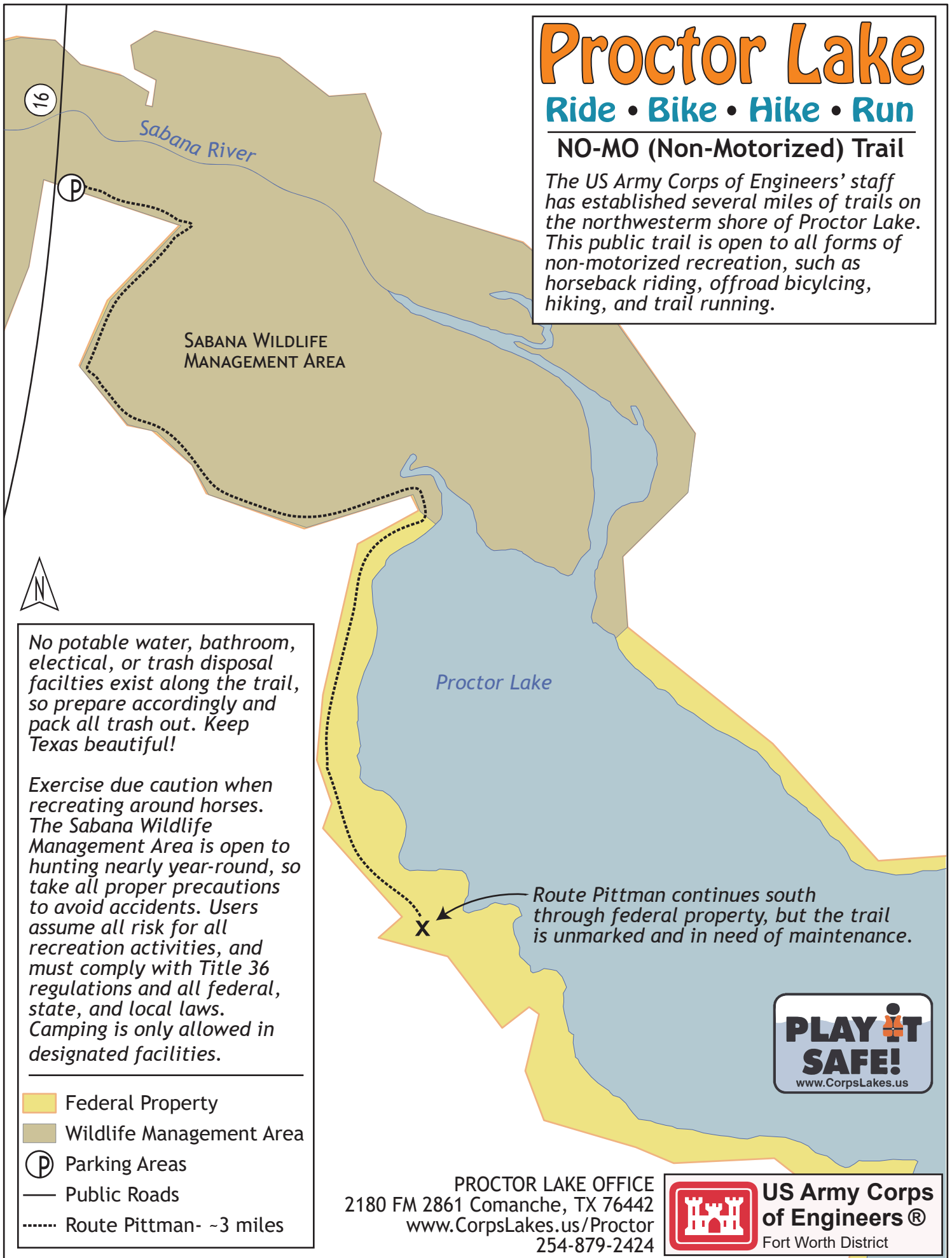


# Proctor Lake

## NO-MO (Non-Motorized) Trail

The US Army Corps of Engineers' staff has established several miles of trails on the northwestern shore of Proctor Lake. This public trail is open to all forms of non-motorized recreation, such as horseback riding, offroad bicycling, hiking, and trail running.



No potable water, bathroom, electrical, or trash disposal facilities exist along the trail, so prepare accordingly and pack all trash out. Keep Texas beautiful!

Exercise due caution when recreating around horses. The Sabana Wildlife Management Area is open to hunting nearly year-round, so take all proper precautions to avoid accidents. Users assume all risk for all recreation activities, and must comply with Title 36 regulations and all federal, state, and local laws. Camping is only allowed in designated facilities.
