Waterfowl Blind Selection Procedures

Seasonal waterfowl blind drawing applications will be accepted between May 1 and August 31 of each year. Cards are required to be delivered in person or by mail before 4:30pm on August 31, cards received after that will no longer be entered into the drawing. Waterfowl blind applications must be sent to the following address to be placed in the random drawing. Only one (1) card is allowed per applicant.

Individuals must be eighteen years old or older to apply. The duck blind application shall be a white 3" X 5" note or index card with the following information on it.

- Name as it appears on Driver's License or State ID Card
- Address at it appears on Driver's License or State ID Card, with city and zip code
- Both daytime and evening telephone numbers
- Email address that is frequently checked

A random drawing will be conducted for waterfowl blinds at the Somerville Lake Office on September 3. Individuals on randomly drawn cards will be notified by e-mail and MUST meet at the Somerville Lake Office on the Wednesday following the drawing at 7:00p.m. to select waterfowl blind location and complete required forms. Individuals failing to attend the meeting forfeit the opportunity to select a waterfowl blind location. Blind selection will be conducted in the order in which the cards were randomly drawn. Two individuals will be allowed to attend the selection meeting. The first individual is the individual on the randomly drawn card, this individual MUST show a valid Driver's License or State ID prior to selecting the waterfowl blind location and will select the blind location. The second individual is allowed to attend only as the alternate and will sign as the alternate on the permit. Individuals selected for a blind will be charged a \$50.00 non-refundable fee, that is REQUIRED when you select your blind at the selection meeting. This fee MUST be in the form of a personal check, cashier's check or money order, NO cash will be accepted. After waterfowl blind locations are selected, construction of blinds can begin at anytime. All waterfowl blinds **MUST** be removed within 30 days after the season ends. For questions or comments contact the lake office at 979-596-1622. Capital Regional Office staff members and immediate family will not be allowed to participate for these hunts.
