
SOMERVILLE TRAILWAY is a 26-mile, round-trip, multi-use trail. A detailed map of the trailway is available at Park Headquarters.

PLEASE NOTE

- CHECK OUT time is 12 p.m. or renew permit by 9 a.m. (pending site availability).
- After office hours late arrivals must check in by 9 a.m.
- Public consumption or display of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited.
- A maximum of eight people permitted per campsite. Guests must leave the park by 10 p.m. Quiet time is from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m.; unnecessary vehicle operation is prohibited during quiet hours.
- Two vehicles per site including trailers (excess vehicle fee). Park on pavement only.
- GRAY WATER AND BLACK WATER MUST BE DISCHARGED ONLY AT DUMP STATIONS.
- Pets must be kept on leash of not more than six feet; pets must not be left unattended. Please pick up after them.
- Firearms and fireworks are prohibited. Gathering of firewood is prohibited.
- Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided.
- Equine users must show proof of a negative EIA (Coggins) test within the past 12 months. The form VS 10-11 is proof of testing.
- All park regulations are posted at park office and all restrooms.
- Stop the spread of invasive species. CLEAN, DRAIN and DRY your boat.
